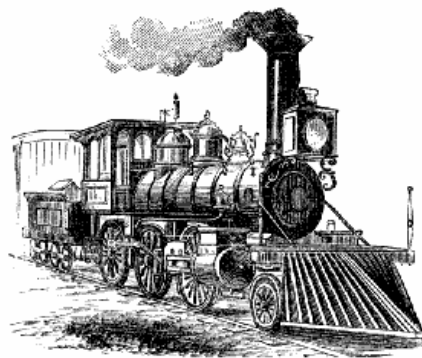

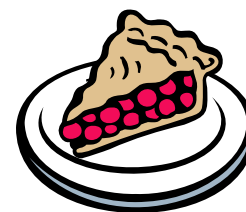
“A Firecracker of a Sale”

CHILDREN'S CORNER

The Grant Area District Library recently received a \$1,050 grant from the Libri Foundation of Eugene, Oregon.

The Libri Foundation was established in 1989 for the purpose of helping rural libraries acquire new, quality, hardcover children's books they could not otherwise afford to buy.

The foundation supports the idea that children who learn to enjoy reading at an early age continue to read throughout their lives.

The Friends of the Grant Area District Library raised \$350 from the book and bake sales which are held four times per year.

The foundation matched this money at a two to one ratio, giving the children's department a total of \$1,050 for the purchase of new children's materials.
